The Ice Cream and Coffee House ministry was busy in the summer and fall and we were able to build a little financial reserve for the winter. That reserve is being consumed in the winter months as the sales are not covering the expenses. Our goal is to build relationships and so we are committed to maintain consistent and robust hours of operation. We are seeing God do amazing things as our Church family is simply showing up and "being there".

Thanks to a year-end pledge we just began work on a much needed \$5000 acoustic renovation of our space. This will help with Sunday Morning Worship, daily conversations, and groups using our space. We were able to get all that we needed to open and operate Cherry Hill in 2020 and are very thankful.
