### "First Things First"

I am sure this sounds familiar. Early in our dealing with COVID issues as a church, not even beginning to understand what we were dealing with or how long it would last, we unceremoniously made this a motto of our approach. We decided that even if for the sake of safety of our members we had to meet differently taking special precautions, or even temporarily not even meet in the building, we would emphasize the Biblical "first things first" of the Church. We took this from a look at what the first Church did in Acts 2. We looked at what was preached in that first sermon and how people responded to it in belief, repentance and baptism. We looked at how the Church began to function as a Church, continuing in the Apostle's teaching, in fellowship, in breaking of bread, and in prayer. We looked at how they worshipped God in both large and small groups, in temple courts and in homes, praising God for His grace through Jesus. We looked at how they shared what they had and served the needs of others. We said that these are the "first things" of the Church, and we studied all of Paul's letters to the churches and found that in all his writings he emphasized these "first things first." We decided as a church, the Graham Street Church of Christ, that is what we would do, no matter happened with COVID, not matter what changes, we would keep the "first things first." Wes, Taylor and I put together some recorded video Bible study material for small groups that is still online for the church to use that emphasizes this principle, "first things first."

Now we have come to a time in which we have decided to "restart" some of the things that have helped us do the "first things first," for example, our Bible classes at the building and small groups in homes. To some extent we have done both during COVID, but not in the same way as before. Now we are proposing "restarting" Sunday morning Bible classes for all ages Jan. 24, and we will have a lunch meeting Sunday (Jan. 17) with the teachers and other volunteers needed to make this happen. We will also have a meeting Sunday night (Jan. 17) at 5:00 in the auditorium to talk about ways to offer more small groups. We need to remember that these are methods for doing "first things first," and there are other ways to continue to do the "first things" should we have to change our approach. Let's try to not make the method more important than the mission, and should we need to make adjustments in the method to achieve the mission, be flexible.
