IMMUTABILITY

- > God cannot change
- > A foundational important attribute

IMMUTABILITY: SCRIPTURAL DATA

- > Unchangeable in His existence
- > Unchanging in His character
- > Unchangeable in His faithfulness
- > Unchangeable in His wisdom

but you are the same, and your years have no end.

PSALM 102:27

"For I the Lord do not change; therefore you, O children of Jacob, are not consumed.

MALACHI 3:6

Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow due to change.

SYSTEMATIC SUMMARY

- > Two Views
 - > Traditional View
 - > Revised View

TRADITIONAL VIEW

- > Neo-Platonic
- > Completely Immovable
- > Unmoved Mover
 - We change not because of anything God does but due to us being moved with admiration

TRADITIONAL VIEW

- > Problem
 - > God is not static
 - > God is active with people and events

TYPICALTRADITIONAL ARGUMENT

- > God is the most perfect being
- > Nothing could be done to improve Him
- > Therefore any change would make Him less than perfect
 - >> Problems?

REVISED VIEW

- > God's life does not change
- > God's character does not change
- > God's truth does not change
- > God's ways do not change
- > God's purposes do not change
- > God's Son does not change

LIFE

- > God has to exist
- > Part of his aseity
- > Neither matures nor regresses
- > Does not increase or decrease in perfection

CHARACTER

- Unchangeable in mercy, love, faithfulness, justice, etc.
- > Constant

TRUTH

- > God's Word cannot change
- Doesn't mean he can't have different covenants with different people

WAYS

- > Consistent in dealing with humanity
- > Punishes sin
- >> Bestows grace

PURPOSES

- > God's plans do not change
- > God's plans are from eternity past
- > God's knows eternity forward
- > His purposes are perfect

SON

> Same yesterday, today, and forever

APPLICATION

- > First, God is the source of stability in our life
- > Secondly, God is always receptive
- > Third, we are secure in our relationship with God

SOURCE OF STABILITY

- > God is our rock
- > Eternal permanence and stability

The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer, my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.

PSALM 18:2

For God alone, O my soul, wait in silence, for my hope is from him. He only is my rock and my salvation, my fortress; I shall not be shaken. On God rests my salvation and my glory; my mighty rock, my refuge is God.

RECEPTIVE

- > God isn't moody
- > God can't be compromised
- > You don't come to God on your terms- you come to God on his terms

SECURE

- > If we deny him, he will deny us
- > If we are faithless, he is still faithful
