- > Not the Book

AUTHORITY

- > "...the right to demand belief and obedience."
- > Levels of Authority
 - > Subsidiary Authority
 - >> Parents
 - >> State
 - \gg God

GODIS THE SUPREME AUTHORITY

- "...has the right... to demand belief and obedience unconditionally from us."
- > So how can we know His plan?

GOD'S AUTHORITY

"If God is the ultimate authority who directs our lives, command us to live in certain ways, and requires us to believe certain things, how do we know God's will and mind on any subject, so as to follow His authority?"

OUR DEFINITION OF REVELATION

- "Revelation is the disclosure of God's will and mind on something."
- ➤ It is how God has chosen to reveal Himself to us. (Unveiling)

TWO TYPES & TWO DEFINITIONS

- > Definitions
 - >> Broad Revelation
 - > Any Communication From God
 - ➤ General Info from Bible & Revealed in Nature
 - > Narrow Revelation
 - > Hidden Information Such As Prophecy

TWO TYPES & TWO DEFINITIONS

- > Types
 - > General Revelation
 - > Special Revelation

GENERAL REVELATION

- > Senses of General Revelation
 - > Generally Available
 - > General Information

GENERALLY AVAILABLE

- Information that is not restricted to certain people, times or places.
- > Available to all mankind

GENERALINFORMATION

- General Information About Who God Is, But Not Specific
 - Ex. Creation Shows A Powerful Creator, But Not The Trinity.

TYPES OF GENERAL REVELATION

- > Nature
- > Conscience

NATURE

➤ All People Can Know There Is A Creator Based On Creation Itself

18 For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men, who by their unrighteousness suppress the truth. 19 For what can be known about God is plain to them, because God has shown it to them. 20 For his invisible attributes, namely, his eternal power and divine nature, have been clearly perceived, ever since the creation of the world, in the things that have been made. So they are without excuse.

CONSCIENCE

> A Common Moral Code In Each of Us

- 1. To Show Forth God's Glory
- 2. To Render People Morally Culpable Before God
- 3. To Make Salvation Through Christ Universally Acceptable
- 4. To Stabilize Human Society

TO SHOW FORTH GOD'S GLORY

- > Creation Testifies To A Creator
- > It Shows Us His Power

1 The heavens declare the glory of God, and the sky above proclaims his handiwork.

TO RENDER PEOPLE MORALLY CULPABLE

- > Morally Guilty
- > We Know Right and Wrong
