#### **Session Meeting Notes**



During the December Session meeting the following items were covered:

- Clerk of Session, Mary Linkous, reported that the 2019 Session Meeting Minutes were reviewed and approved as part of the Presbytery Minute Review process.
- Pastor Don announced plans for a weekly online Bible study entitled "First Look" to begin in January, 2021. He
  explained that this will incorporate an online class for prospective new members.
- The motion passed to approve 2021 Communions on January 3, February 17, April 1, May 2, August 29 and Oct 3.
- It was noted that the online Congregational meeting and voting worked well—and appreciation was extended to Rev. Dr. Michael Wilson for his assistance in the process. It was also noted that our on-line worship services have been running more smoothly each week. That is attributed to the new equipment and software that was purchased for the sanctuary, and to the time and effort put into the productions by Don Wilson and Hugh McPherson, who were thanked for their work.
- The Session agreed on the questions to be included in a survey being sent to Centre members regarding their vision for our church. The Nominating Committee will be meeting to select members of the Pastoral Nominating Committee. Their report will be presented to the congregation for approval in January.
- It was reported that the Trustees have made the repairs and improvements to the manse their top priority.
- June Stratmeyer was recognized and thanked for her hosting of the Women of Centre meeting in December that included both in-person and Zoom participants.

#### **Calling a Pastor**

With the retirement of Pastor Don Hackett set to begin in July, 2021, our pastoral search process has begun. Here is **what has been accomplished** thus far and **our steps to come**:

#### **Steps in the Pastoral Search Process:**

#### **Session Responsibilities**

- In Oct. 2020, Session approved the retirement of Pastor Hackett to commence on July 1, 2021.
- In Nov. 2020, the <u>Donegal Presbytery Executive Presbyter and Stated Clerk visited</u> Session to review the steps of the call process.
- In Nov. 2020, our Session voted to begin the process to search for a full time, installed pastor.
- In Dec. 2020, our Session will conduct a survey of our members to help determine the future direction of our church mission and leadership.
- In Dec. 2020, our <u>Personnel Committee and Treasurer will prepare</u> a financial review, pastor position description, pastor search budget, compensation package range, and other documents for Session and the Presbytery's Connecting our Ministries Commission (COM) review and approval.
- The <u>Nominating Committee will seek recommendations</u> for the Pastor Nominating Committee to present to the congregation for approval in early 2021.

#### Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC)

- Presbytery will <u>coach the PNC</u> in how to proceed.
- PNC will prepare a <u>Ministry Information Form</u> (MIF) to be approved by Session and COM.
- PNC will <u>advertise the position, receive resumes, interview candidates, select</u> a candidate for vote, and present the terms of call to Session for approval.
- The candidate will meet with the Presbytery of Donegal's COM to discuss the fit between the candidate and Centre, and membership in the presbytery.
- The candidate will be <u>introduced to the congregation</u> in various ways.
- A <u>congregational meeting</u> will be held to meet and vote on whether or not to request that the Presbytery of Donegal install the candidate as Centre's next pastor.
- PNC will oversee the welcome and ongoing support of the approved candidate.

Please be praying for wisdom as we discern our direction and leadership for the future.

Per Capita is "the tie that binds" — annual giving that unites the entire church in the ongoing and essential work that guides the Office of the General Assembly, the life of the Presbyterian Church (USA) and benefits every congregation and every mid council ministry. Per capita is the primary source of funding for the Office of the General Assembly, and is how Presbyterians mutually and equitably share the costs of coming together to discern the Spirit's leading for the future.

- It is how Presbyterians are trained to become better ruling elders, deacons, and ministers of word and sacrament/teaching elders.
- It is how Presbyterians come together to discern God's call in their lives.
- It is how Presbyterians participate in the life of the wider church by serving on General Assembly committees and commissions, regardless of distance or financial resources.
- It is how Presbyterians participate in the life of the Church universal as we commit ourselves to work and live in fellowship with "all persons in every nation".

For 2021 the per capita is \$35.38 per member. Those contributions are being accepted now. You can contribute your share by marking your check "per capita" or by using the designated blue "per capita" envelope and mailing to the church (or give electronically via our website). **Thank you!** It is a joy to partner in ministry and mission.
