PRAYERTIME

STARTING QUESTIONS

READ THIS TOGETHER 1 John 4:20 20 If anyone says, "I love God," and yet hates his brother or sister, he is a liar. For the person who does not love his brother or sister whom he has seen cannot love God whom he has not seen.

SCRIPTURAL APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Why do you think this verse uses such strong language like "Liar" when talking about how we treat our brothers and sisters?

Have you ever thought about how your friends might experience God's love by the way that you love them? What are your thoughts about a statement like that? Does this feel like added pressure?



RANDOM ACTS OF KINDNESS

Go out as a family with the goal to bless someone else this next week. Pray for God to reveal a person or family that you can bless. Maybe for your family it is buying the groceries of someone in line or simply buying their soda at the gas station, or you choose to pull in all the garbage cans on your street
