# Participation Plan

Onboarding	The list of registered students will be vetted with Pastor Booker, since this year there are no minimum age requirements. Students accepted into the program will be sent a welcome email with orientation instructions.
Orientation	The first form of participation will be a program orientation. It will be extremely important that the student attends orientation to understand the expectations of the program and its execution. It will also be extremely helpful to become familiar with the technology that will be used and give an opportunity to troubleshoot any issues prior to a class with actual course content.
<ul><li>In-Person Class Attendance</li><li>&amp; Interaction</li></ul>	Students attending in-person each week will be expected to arrive promptly at the start of each class and participate by asking or answering questions and completing the quizzes at the end of class time.
<b>Online</b> Class Attendance & Interaction	Students attending remotely each week will be expected to be present on the livestream promptly at the start of each class and participate by asking or answering questions digitally and completing the quizzes at the end of class time.
Quizzes (1/3 of grade)	Quizzes will be worth 1/3 of the course grade and will be administered during the class time, both online and in-person through Google Forms, which will require a smartphone, tablet, or laptop. Paper forms or a verbal quiz can be made available upon request. Exceptions will be granted on a case-by-case basis for those who miss a class and would like to make up the quiz after watching the class recording.
Homework (1/3 of grade)	Homework will collectively count toward 1/3 of the course grade and will be administered weekly and should be submitted via email before the following week's class time. Exceptions will be granted on a case-by-case basis for late homework.
Final Exam (1/3 of grade)	The final exam will be worth 1/3 of the course grade and will be administered on the last week of the program.
Course Completion	A passing grade will be considered anything above an "F".
Special Events	Throughout the program, special events will be promoted (e.g., extra- curricular seminars or presentations, prayer and evangelism meet-ups, celebration dinner, etc.). Attendance to these events will be purely at the discretion of the student and will not negatively impact the final grade; however, they will offer the student extra credit.
Graduation Ceremony	The graduation ceremony will be conducted at Inland Lighthouse Church in Rialto, CA where certificates and special gifts will be given to each student that successful completes the program with a passing grade.
