- Read 1 Peter 4:1-11. What way of thinking does Peter say we should accept in verse 1? Who is to be our example when it comes to dealing with suffering? See also 1 Peter 3:21-23.
- How does suffering make it possible to receive God's grace? Who has God used recently in your life to share His love in a time of suffering?
- What is the sense of urgency that seems to motivate Peter in verses 3-7? How should this effect our mindset?
- When you think about showing hospitality, what comes to your mind? When have you been the recipient of hospitality? How did it make you feel? When have you been the extender of hospitality? How did it make you feel?
- Why do you think Peter says we should express hospitality without grumbling? When is showing hospitality inconvenient?
- How is using our spiritual giftedness and expression of loving one another earnestly?
- How do verses 10-11 encourage you when it comes to speaking or acting on behalf of God? How does God's grace effect our speaking and our serving?
- Can you recall a time when you felt inadequate to speak or act in a loving way and God gave you the words or the strength to do so?
- According to verse 11, what is the purpose for God's grace being given to us to speak and act lovingly?
- Take some time to pray and ask God to give you the grace you need to walk through each day. Who can you love earnestly this week?
