I would ask that you please pray for me as I will be leaving for the USA on Christmas Day to help my parents for a couple of months. A couple of weeks ago my dad had an accident while hunting in the woods and broke his leg. He has had 2 surgeries to repair the injuries and then recently was in the hospital with blood clots on both lungs. His health is improving, but there is still a lengthy and difficult recovery ahead.

I would like to thank you for your prayers for my foot surgery in September. The surgery and recovery have gone quite well. I am not quite 3 months out and already back to fairly normal. Right before my surgery the Lord opened up a cottage for me to move in that is right across the street from the Little Fish Ministry property. What a blessing it is to live on a farm that is within walking distance of the property.

Thank you to all who have given towards the LFM clinic and nurse housing. As of right now, the Lord has brought in just a little over \$10,000. A total of \$50,000 needs to be raised for this project. Most abandoned children that come into our care will need immediate medical attention, and often ongoing care, so the need for building a medical clinic is imperative!
