""Renewing an Old Tradition"

I know many of you are eager to get back to one worship service on Sunday mornings, while there are others who feel it is best for us to continue with two services as long as statistics show the virus is still very dangerous and spreading so we can social distance as recommended by the CDC. Some are very excited about our efforts to restart the Bible Classes and Small Groups, while others are concerned that group meetings in small spaces increases the potential to spread the virus. I want to assure you that our Elders are very aware of both views and want to move forward with meeting together in one service as quickly as it is safe to do so. They evaluate the situation every month and consider what adjustments need to be made. It's a great time for us to evaluate our worship traditions and make improvements.

We have started something new on the 2nd and 4th Sunday Nights. As you know we have designated the 1st and 3rd Sunday nights for small group meetings. On the 2nd and 4th Sunday nights we have the Family Bible Class in the Family Center for parents and young children, and we have a Sunday night worship service in the auditorium. It is not new to have a Sunday night worship service. In fact, this is an old tradition among American churches that has for many become obsolete, but what we are doing with it is new to our tradition here at Graham Street, as far as I know. We are working on our worship. Sounds a bit strange to say that. We are working on better understanding and feeling our worship. One example of how we are working on our worship is to improve our singing. Not just in the performance, although we do want to improve it to where we offer the very best we can for praising God and edifying one another, but we are also trying to improve our awareness of God's purpose for our singing and how to do our very best to fulfill that purpose.
