Ash Wednesday this year occurs on February 17<sup>th</sup>. With it begins the season of Lent, which leads us eventually to Good Friday and Easter Sunday. We will, as usual, hold an Ash Wednesday service that evening to begin our Lent with a reflection upon our human frailty and need for salvation.

I recall, attending another small church much like our own as a teenager, that Ash Wednesday was not recognized at all. The fact is, although the practice of holding Ash Wednesday services goes back to the 10<sup>th</sup> century, many Protestant churches, and especially most Methodist churches, ignored this holy day until only in recent decades.

Even John Wesley himself appears to downplay Ash Wednesday and Lent itself. In a prayer book he created for American Methodists, he left them out entirely with the terse explanation that they were, "at present answering no valuable end." Some believe today that his reason for omitting them was the fact that Methodism, as it existed then, already placed so much emphasis on regular fasting, prayer, and confession that it was unnecessary to set apart particular days for these practices. However, Wesley's own very anti-Catholic bias probably colored his decision, too. It certainly did so for generations of later Methodists as well, who saw Ash Wednesday and Lent as "Catholic" practices.

However, the mid-20<sup>th</sup> century began to change this point of view. The 1965 Book of Worship introduced an "ashless" Ash Wednesday service, focused entirely on preaching, prayer, and scripture. It was only with the current, 1992 Book of Worship that an Ash Wednesday service with imposition of Ashes was added to official United Methodist practice.

Whether you have been used to Ash Wednesday or not, I encourage you to take part in our service on the 17<sup>th</sup>. Ash Wednesday is one of the most introspective and spiritual moments of our church year, and reminds us that we are dust, and to dust we shall return.

#### 2020 OUTREACH SUMMARY Matthew 22:39..."Love your neighbor as yourself."

The Outreach/Missions committee provides the congregation with the opportunities to actively participate in mission activities on a local, state, national and international level. It educates the laity on missions. Included in this ministry category are Church World Service projects, local needs, and national and international projects sponsored by the United Methodist Church.

#### MINISTRY HIGHLIGHTS:

**Sponsored** one blood drive which collected a total of 18 units (14 singles and 2 doubles) Some other people attempted to donate but were deferred. COVID canceled the other drives.

Collected monetary offerings for Habitat, FISH, Blanket/Tool Sunday

**Delivered** Amerigas coupons to New Market Elementary

Collected food, clothing, and linens for the FISH pantries throughout the year

**Worked** regularly at the local FISH clothing pantry

**Represented** our church at FISH board meetings

**Encouraged** monetary donations for Mental Health Christmas gifts Physical donations were banned due to COVID.

**Coordinated** the congregation's schedule to ring the Salvation Army bell one day \$814.90

**Volunteered** in different areas in the community (free clinic, schools, Christmas dinner in Crawfordsville, etc.)

Coordinated donating money to UMCOR

**Sponsored** four Food Finders food drives helping approximately 623 families Extra food was taken to women's shelters and local church food pantries. Local churches helped.

There are other mission projects that are not coordinated by the Outreach committee. Hopefully 2021 will restore/enhance our missions.

#### **NEW MARKET UNITED METHODIST WOMEN**

Five women met in the home of Sue Foy January 6, 2021. President Foy opened the meeting at 7:00 P. M. reading from Blessings. People need to find gladness in tasks they need to do instead of dreading the jobs.

**New Business:** The programs for 2021 were completed.

Brooke Pike then conducted the pledge service using Matthew 25:35-36. The money that the local UMW donates throughout the year is combined with other offerings to help programs in the Philippines (saving women and young boys and girls from sex trafficking), in India (saving child brides), in China (teaching women job skills), in South America (helping women with prenatal care), in Texas (helping children with behavioral issues), in Alaska (assisting children of traumas), in Canada (establishing bilingual day cares). There are many other programs throughout the world. The women then formed a yarn web showing the connectivity and work done in our local area by our own church. All women working together can provide help for many groups and individuals. The group collected \$210 in pledges. Anyone wanting to add to the pledge may give her money to Sheila.

The meeting closed at 8:20 P. M. The next meeting is February 3, 2020, in fellowship hall. The program is the Call to Prayer and Self Denial. Any woman may join the group. All are welcomed.


