As We Gather: We learn much from Peter in today's Gospel. Initially, Peter seems to understand Jesus. When Jesus asks, "Who do you say that I am?" Peter responds with the right words, "You are the Christ." Jesus commends him for these right words. Yet when Jesus began to teach what it meant for Him to be the Christ—suffering, death, resurrection—Peter objected, revealing that he did not really understand what it meant that Jesus was the Christ. So Jesus said to him, "Get behind Me, Satan." On this second Sunday in Lent, this episode serves as both a powerful warning and a profound calling to us. Following Jesus is not easy; it is a path of taking up our cross and following Him. And His path went through suffering and death to resurrection. Baptized into Christ, that is our path too, by the grace of the One who walked it first. Ours will, at times, be a path of suffering, and so the words of Paul to the church in Rome ring powerfully in our ears today: "Therefore, since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ" (Romans 5:1).
