LESSONS FROM FIRST SAMUEL

1 Samuel 2:12-17 "Eli's sons were priests and scoundrels; they had no regard for the Lord. ¹³ Now it was the practice of the priests that, whenever any of the people offered a sacrifice, the priest's servant would come with a three-pronged fork in his hand while the meat was being boiled ¹⁴ and would plunge the fork into the pan or kettle or caldron or pot. Whatever the fork brought up the priest would take for himself. This is how they treated all the Israelites who came to Shiloh. ¹⁵ But even before the fat was burned, the Eli's sons' servant would come and say to the person who was sacrificing, "Give the priest some meat to roast; he won't accept boiled meat from you, but only raw." ¹⁶ If the person said to him, "Let the fat be burned first, and then take whatever you want," the servant would answer, "No, hand it over now; if you don't, I'll take it by force." ¹⁷ This sin of the young men was very great in the Lord's sight, for they were treating the Lord's offering with contempt."

LESSONS TO LEARN:

- Don't be greedy with what is the Lord's.
 - Eli's sons were treating the Lord's offering with contempt. In the qualifications for elders (1 Timothy 3:3) and the qualifications for deacons (1 Timothy 3:8) we find that the leaders of God's people are not to be lovers of money... greedy. Hopefully this will enable them to avoid misusing the offerings made to the Lord.
 - All Christians are to refrain from being greedy. Colossians 3:5 says we are to "put to death" greed in our lives. Ephesians 5:3 says "there must not be even a hint of" greed in our lives. And the reason is found in 1 Corinthians 6:10 and Ephesians 5:5... that a greedy person "will not inherit the kingdom of God."
- Share what is the Lord's.
 - Instead of being greedy with what is the Lord's, Christians should share their blessings from the Lord. Romans 12:13 "**Share** with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality." Hebrews 13:16 "And do not forget to do good and to **share** with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased."
