<u>February 28, 2021 BLUEPRINT FOR A HEALTHY CHURCH: Living in the Past or Pardoned?</u>

<u>TEXT: Titus 3:3-7</u> At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures. We lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another. But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ our Savior, so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.

- 1) **REMEMBER THE PAST:** Verse 3 At one time we too were foolish, disobedient, deceived and enslaved by all kinds of passions and pleasures. We lived in malice and envy, being hated and hating one another.
 - **Foolish:** Ephesians 4:18 They are darkened in their understanding and separated from the life of God because of the ignorance that is in them due to the hardening of their hearts.
 - Disobedient:
 - <u>Deceived:</u> I Peter 2:25 For you were like sheep going astray, but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.
 - Proverbs 4:23 Above all else, guard your heart, for everything you do flows from it.
 - Enslaved to passions and pleasures: John 8:34 Jesus replied, "I tell you the truth, everyone who sins is a slave to sin.
 - Living in malice:
 - **Envious:** Proverbs 14:30 A heart at peace gives life to the body, but envy rots the bones.
 - Being hated and hating others:
- 2) REMEMBER WHO YOU ARE: VERSES 4-7 But when the kindness and love of God our Savior appeared, he saved us, not because of righteous things we had done, but because of his mercy. - <u>3) RESULTS OF RECEIVING:</u> Verse 7 "...so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life."
