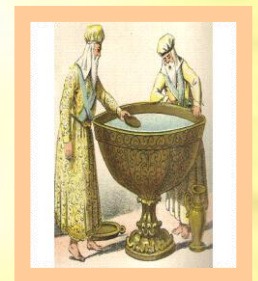
A Few Hebrew Definitions

- Sum/census (Exod 30:12) H7218 ראש ro'sh:** Literally to Shake, the sum or census after the shaking. "Everything that can be shaken will be shaken," and, "Will you be counted in His next census???"
- Plague (Ex 30:12) H5063 נגף Negeph from nagaph:** Striking, plague, or to Stumble, lag behind.
- Ransom (Exod 30:12) H3724 כפר kopher:** price of a life, ransom, bribe, (as a covering). From the root word כפר H3722 **kaphar:** To cover over, atone for sin, make atonement
- Anointed/anointing (Exod 30:25) H4888 משחה mishchah:** Consecrated unto HIM. (Notice the root similarities to the other Hebrew words we have studied.)
- Oil (Exod 30:25) H8081 שמן shemen:** Olive oil for anointing.
- Sign (mark) (Exod 31:13) H22 אות oth:** A sign, signal, a distinguishing mark, omen, warning, and miracle.
- Mark (sign) (Ezek 9:4; 9:6) H8420 תו tav:** Desire, mark (as a sign of exemption from judgment).
- Delayed (Ex 32:1) H954 בוש bush:** To put to shame, be ashamed, to pale or diminish.
- Anger (Exod 32:19) H639 אף aph:** Anger(-gry) from the rapid breathing in passion, forbearing, suffering. *God suffers!!!*
- Rock (Exod 33:21) H6697 צר tsur:** God's rock, rock of salvation (Deut 32:15), or rock (of heathen gods Deut 32:31). Deut 32 is the 2nd song of Moses and it's all about the Rock of our Salvation, Yeshua.



Notes that point to Yeshua

- Ex 30:11-16—The Atonement Shekel.** Everyone that doesn't want "plagues" must be atoned for and counted (Num 1 & 26, Census). "Plagues" means to stumble or lag behind, and eventually captured or smitten. If you're going to walk for the Lord (for 40 years), you don't want to be the one being captured because you stumbled. Look at this in today's Spirit!
- Ex 30:17-21—The Basin for Washing. Ps 24:4 and James 4:8**—This is our instruction for priests to come into service to God. Wash your hands to have a clean, pure heart. **Another "forever" statute.** This is only for the Priesthood, the Kingdom of Priests. **That's YOU!!**
- Ex 30:22-38**—His instruction for **His oil & incense** is very precise. **HIS way**, not ours. His way is the Holy Way, Kodesh. Remember this is not the "common" referred to in **Ezek 44:23-24.**
- Ex 31:1-11**, Filled with His Holy Spirit, Bezalel & Oholiab are chosen to make the holy articles to serve Yahweh. It has always been the same—we are to be filled with His Holy Spirit to Serve HIM. **The OT Prophets were filled with the Holy Spirit: 1Pe 1:10-11** "... the Spirit of Yeshua in them (the prophets) did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Messiah, and the glory that should follow."
- Ex 31:12-18—The Sign: Sabbath.** Do you think that God just decided to not care when we Honor His Sign? Do you see where it says, **"forever and to all generations?"** This is restated several times in **Ezek 20:12, 20.** His sign (oth) is also in Passover, **Ex 13:9**; Spiritual Tefillin, **Deut 6:8**; when He puts the word in you, **Deut 11:18**; and also if you walk in curses, **Deut 28:46.**



DO YOU Gather?

- a. **The Sign or mark used here for Sabbath is the Aleph א** (alpha), and the sign in **Ezek 9:4** is the **Tav ט** (Omega). We need both the physical and the spiritual. The physical in Sabbath, Passover, and His Torah. But the sign in Ezek is the last letter of the Hebrew alphabet, the Tav ט—this is both Moses and Elijah from the Mt. of Transfiguration. This Tav is the broken heart that comes from the Holy Spirit.
6. **Ex 32:1—Moses delayed. This word means to pale or diminish.** As Moses diminished, why didn't they call upon Yahweh? Instead they went to the next man, Aaron. Where were the 'consecrated ones from **Ex 13:1-2**???
7. **Ex 32:8-9 (Holy Spirit please help us to see this powerful illustration of us.)** This is an offering to "The God that brought them out of Egypt," **verses 4 and 8.** Please note this was not a bad thing to them—they are thanking the Elohim that saved them. Can you see US in the way we praise HIM, the way we worship Him, the way we give offerings to Yahweh? It has always been "Our Way." God really cares. It does matter how and when we worship—His order (Siddur), HIS WAY!!! Please stop doing it your way, the church's way. Stop honoring (even in good intentions) your way, the golden calf way. Then He makes a reference to us, V.9 "You stiff necked people," same as a hard heart.
- a. Do we do anything similar to make God-Yahweh-Yeshua (they're the same) a little angry??? Can you think of the ways in which we honor the world, idols, areas or things that have our hearts??? We say, "Surely, now God doesn't really get angry with us—we have grace and Jesus." Is He the same yesterday, today and forever??
- b. Does the fear of God begin to make sense to you? **Rom 3:18; Psa 36:1; 111:10; Prov 1:7, 9:10. Psa 25:14** "The secret of the LORD is with them that fear Him; and He will show them His covenant."
8. **Ex 32:22-24, Then Aaron acted just like a small child,** with excuses and justifications: "It's not my fault, I didn't do anything wrong, it's all them. I just threw the gold into the fire and wha-la, out popped this calf, the god who brought them out of Egypt." Does this sound like the stuff we say?? Excuses, justifications, lies!! The traditions of men that we call our godly life will have to be burned out, unless we give it to Yahweh. We are accountable no matter how much we act like Aaron!!!!!!!!!!!!
9. **Ex 32:26, Moses Says "MIY YHVH EL?"** Who is God's? The 1st Born from **Ex 13:1-2** didn't show up. Where are they today? **I Cor 15:23; Rom 8:23; Col 1:18; James 1:18; Rev 1:5.**
10. **Ex 33:1-2,** Because of God's disappointment in His Israel (us), He says, "*I will not go with you. I will send an angel before you.*"
11. **Ex 33:1-23,** Moses pleads and petitions Yahweh, and God says, "*My presence will go with you.*" Why did Moses have God's ear?? Then God seals Moses in HIM as He puts him in the cleft of the Rock, (Yeshua). (See **Heb 11:26**—Moses knew Christ.) The Rock is always God's Salvation. His Rock, **Ps 18:2.**
- a. *1Co 10:4 "...for they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them: and that Rock was Yeshua."*
12. **Ex 34,** The Lord allows us by His Grace (chane) and mercy (chesed) to have another set of tablets, this time on our hearts and minds (**Ezek 36:26, Jer 31:31-34, Heb 8:8-12**). Now is the time, the appointed time, to make a real commitment to the covenant that's on our hearts!!!
13. **Ex 34:6-7—God's testament, HIS testimony**—wow, don't forget this one: "*Yahweh passed by before him, and proclaimed, Yahweh! Yahweh, a merciful and gracious God (El), slow to anger and abundant in loving kindness and truth, keeping loving kindness for thousands, forgiving iniquity and disobedience and sin; and who will by no means clear the guilty, visiting the iniquity of the fathers on the children, and on the children's children, on the third and on the fourth generation.*"
14. **Ex 34:12, don't embrace the things of this world**—the enemy has ulterior motives attached to everything.
15. **Ex 34:13, Make a clean break; clean up** all the places of worship and altars, in YOU. Purify and cleanse your heart (now!).
16. **Ex 34:14, anything can be another God!** When we allow other things to come into our lives (little gods), look at what happens to our lives, our children's lives, the lives of those who are in our area of covering: they are enslaved to the areas of unclean and (tamei) death in the world. It may look good and enticing, but it all leads to death.
17. **Ex 34:18 These are God's feast Days!** **V.20**—Never come into God's presence empty-handed.
- a. **V. 21** Sabbaths, all of the festivals are a special Sabbath, Shabbaton.
- b. **V. 18** Passover, He is our Pesach lamb.
- c. **V. 19** The Firstborn, (Firstfruits, Col 1:20) Ha Bikkurim, is now spiritual. Through the Spirit of Adoption, we are to be Yeshua's Firstfruits.
- d. **V. 22** Feast of Weeks, Shavout, (Pentecost)
- e. **V. 22** Gatherings, The feast of Booths, Sukkot.
- f. **V. 23,** The three "Foot Feasts" of Yahweh: Passover, Shavout, and Sukkot.
18. **Ex 34:24, "If, If, If, If you keep My statutes, precepts and commandments, then I will drive out all your enemies."**
19. **Lord, help us to see this next picture of Yeshua at Mt. Sinai/Horeb.** I believe Moses came down with two things: the tablets of stone (letter of the Law which gives death) and the covenant of the Spirit, which gives Life. His life was filled with an inner presence of Yahweh—even his face glowed, but the people refused this presence and veiled HIM. I believe this is a rejection of the New Covenant. This is symbolic of the 50th day, Shavout, and 1500 years later on the 50th day in the upper room, to 120 Israelites God gave His Spirit, for the purpose of "the Kingdom is at hand!!!"
20. **Tune in next week for VaYakhel-And He Assembled: Exodus 35.1-38:20, Haftarah; 1 Kings 7:40-50 (A), 1 Kings 7:13-26(S), 2 Corinthians 9:1-15; Hebrews 9:1-14; Revelation 11:1-13.** We have two guys filled with the Holy Spirit. What is our Holy Spirit doing in the Torah? More keeping the Sabbath Holy—do you think God is making a point to 'All Generations?' **Check out Matt. 23:39 and Luke 13:35: Blessed are you who comes in the name of the Lord!**

Q & A's: Ki Tisa -When You Elevate: Ex 30:11-34:35

1. **Ex 30:11-16—The Atonement Shekel.** What do you think this may represent today in Yeshua? *This is a great picture that all of our redemption is In Yeshua. We all give the same, our lives.*
2. **Ex 30:17-21—The Washing Basin.** This is for the priests before they come into the Lord's Service. Read **James 4:7-8** and **I Cor 15:46** and tell me if you think this has any bearing on us Today before we enter His Service. *This is a lasting ordinance and it is symbolic of the physical coming before the spiritual; it is a cleansing before you minister to the Lord. Are you a priest??*
3. **Ex 30:22-33—The Anointing Oil.** Notice all the places that were anointed—how does this relate to anointing a person? (Relate it to the mind, the ear lobe, the right thumb, the right great toe and the head.) *The oil anointed all the instruments of service and the areas of the body that we need to anoint before we serve HIM. This is for all generations.*
4. **Ex 30:31, If this oil is for all generations to come, then what do you think it is today? And what was it then?** *This was for them and it is for you. Deut 29:15 tells us that it is even for the generations not with us today.*
5. **Ex 31:1-11, Bezaleel was chosen because Yahweh said, "And I have filled him with the Ruach (Spirit) of YHVH."** You and your generations have been chosen to be vessels in the building of the Tabernacle not made with hands—are you like Bezaleel, filled with his Ruach? *It's not too late to seek Him for this anointing, HS.*
6. **Ex 31:12-18, Ever notice as you come more into this walk that Sunday Sabbath and all your old excuses regarding why you don't have to obey Yeshua are fading away? The Sabbath has become Holy to you because Yeshua is causing you to walk in His ways, (Ezek 36:27). What was/is/is to come, the penalty for not keeping God's Sabbath? Has it really changed?? (Think of this as asleep or dead in Christ.)** *The penalty was death. He is the same, so why are many of us asleep in the Lord? In I Thes 4:16, the word for dead (Nekros in the Greek) is a metaphor for spiritually dead. The Word is bringing to life those who are repenting of their pagan ways and returning to Yahweh's Obedience.*
7. **The Sabbath is a sign between Yahweh and US (oth).** What else is a sign or mark from Yahweh? *This is restated several times in Ezek 20:12, 20. His sign (oth) is also in Passover, Ex 13:9; Teffilin, Deut 6:8; When he puts the word in you, Deut 11:18, and if you walk in curses, Deut 28:46.*
8. **Ex 32 The Golden Calf: (I pray the Holy Spirit hits us with this one in our lives.) What god or God did they make the golden calf for?? Did they do it their way (I did it my way) or did they do it God's way??** *See verse 4 & 8. We see they made this to worship the gods that brought them out of Egypt. We know that is Yahweh. Yahweh was a little upset (3000 died), but we need to see this has been us in our desire to worship. We have been doing it on the sun-god worship day and many other "our Way's " but now is the time to do it Yahweh's way.*
9. **Please show me more examples in the word regarding doing it our way instead of Yahweh's way.**
A few examples of doing it "My Way." I am sure YOU can find more.
 - a) Starting with Adam and Eve and eating of the tree of Knowledge, Gen 3.
 - b) Cain bringing the wrong sacrifice, Gen 4.
 - c) The golden calf of the children of Israel, Ex 32.
 - d) Abihu and Nadab (Lev. 10), Aaron's sons.
 - e) Jeroboam establishing his own priests, holy days and building golden calves; 2 Kings 10, 2 Chr 13.
 - f) Uzzah, 2 Sam 6:7.
 - g) Eli's sons Hophni and Phinehas, 1 Sam 4:1-11.
 - h) Ananias and Sapphira, Acts 5.
 - i) Today in the church we have established our own feast days and rituals in which to worship and serve Him instead of doing it His way.
10. **I love what Aaron said to Moses about the making of the golden calf (Ex 32:24). Who does this remind you of? Me, me and mostly me!!! Can you agree? What excuse do we use not to serve Him or not to come together to His Holy Convocations? "It's Not my Fault!!" Who does that sound like??**
11. **In Ex 32:26 Moses asks for all of those who are consecrated to Yahweh, who are HIS, to come to Moses. Read Ex 13:1-2 and tell me who you think should've come unto Moses.** *The consecrated First Born—this should have been His priesthood. Rev 1:5; I Cor 15:23, Romans 8:23, Col 1:18; James 1:18.*
12. **In Ex 33:12-23 Moses convinces Yahweh to be their guide, so what does Yahweh do when He passes by Moses? Who is this Rock??** *Yahweh Places Moses in the Rock; the Rock is Yeshua, I Cor 10:4.*
13. **Ex 34:6-7, Are these the attributes and characteristics of Yahweh or Yeshua??** *Yes, Yes, they are the same!!*
14. **In Ex 34:21, we see a commandment—what can this really mean?? (Don't just think, brass, silver, gold or MasterCard.)** *This is your life, your praise, your everything, Ps 100.*
15. **In Ex 34:23-24, Yahweh commands us to observe three different Moedim. What are these and can you tell me where they are found to be an everlasting ordinance?** *These are called the "foot feasts." (1)Passover, Unleavened and Firstfruits- Lev 23:4-14; (2) Shavout-Lev. 23:21; and (3) Succoth-Lev 23:33-41.*
16. **Ex 34:29-35, It is said that Moses came down on the 50th day from Passover with the Word. Just as we see in Acts 2, there was a receiving of the something. Do you think Moses received anything else from Yahweh besides the Ten Commandments?? And did the masses receive it?? What did they do to Moses??** *We see that Moses came down with the tablets and the Shechinah glory of Yahweh. The people feared the Spirit and put a veil over Moses. This was their rejection of the Spirit or the fullness of the Torah, the heart.*

7-Feast of Tabernacles/ Sukkot	Lev 23:41

Please note:

1. These feast days are all Sabbaths—Shabbaton.
2. The Feast of Trumpets, Shofars, is not a lasting covenant. The time is coming when the alarm will not sound anymore. The "Last Trump/Shofar is sounding". (I heard my last trump!)

We are also commanded to keep the oil in the lamps as a perpetual commandment, Ex 27:20-21; Lev 24:3.

We, the Priests, are to always, or forever have a Fire burning in our altars/hearts, Lev 6:13.

We are never to offer anything to idols or touch blood, Lev 17:7.

The anyone who touches the Holy Bread/Yeshua will be Holy, forever, Lev 6:18.

There is never to be any wine or strong drink in His Presence, only His Spirit, Lev 10:9.

You are being Transformed-Prepared, (One Moment at a time!
