Pray that this lockdown will end soon and that we can reschedule the meetings that were canceled and schedule some more before we leave to go back to Thailand this fall. We have lost nine of our supporting churches and we are asking God to make those up before we leave.

Kristen has been doing great up until this last week. She has been continuing to get her immunizations and all of her counts have been good. Her ferritin levels are high because of all the blood transfusions that she had. They are going to start drawing blood every time she goes in. As her body produces more blood those levels should come down. Last week she began to have pain in her lower back and leg. The Hospital didn't want us to bring her in but it finally got so bad that we had to take her in. She has shingles and is in a lot of pain. She has been in the hospital for the last six days. Please pray that she will get over this quickly and the pain will rescind.
