She still has some complications with her heart and kidneys. She has to go back to Houston in two weeks for some more test to determine if she needs to see a cardiologist and a kidney doctor. They are planning on starting her immunizations then as well. The doctor said she should be able to get all of the immunizations that she needs to go back to Thailand in the next six months. We were hoping that it would not take that long and was a little disappointed with that, but are excited to have some clarity and direction about when we will be able to go back together as a family. Thank you so much for your prayers and encouragement. Please continue to pray, especially for her heart test and kidney test coming up in two weeks.

I have had the opportunity to report and preach in several supporting churches these past two months. I also was able to preach a mission's conference in the St. Louis, Missouri area. The had some newer members that had not been introduced to faith promise missions before and it was good to see their excitement to get involved. I also was able to fill in for a church near home that is without a pastor for several services. I am always thankful for the opportunities that God gives to preach and serve. A few weeks back, my wife and I were out soul winning at our home church. I had the opportunity to lead a man to Christ that morning and at the same time, my son was across town soul winning with our youth pastor. He was able to lead his first soul to Christ. He was so excited to get to do that. I could not have been more proud of him. I'll take that over a home run, or game winning shot any day of the week.

I will be making a trip to Thailand toward the end of this month through July to do some ministry and continue language studies. Please pray for that trip and that everything goes well here with Kristen while I am gone.
