Dear Pastors and Praying Friends,

It is hard to believe that I have been in Knysna for 3 months already. The Lord has already provided me with some amazing ministry opportunities. Part of learning the South African culture has been learning that nothing happens quickly. It is very much a hurry up and wait mentality.

Over the last couple of months, I have had the opportunity to tag along with some of my team mates and observe the ministries the Lord has called them to as well as see the doors open to using my healthcare experience in some of these settings.

At the end of July, I had the opportunity to go to one of the primary schools in the area and spend some time in the classroom. While watching the kids play outside, one of the students fell and skinned her knee (no big deal). However, it took approx 10 minutes for the one first aid kit to be located. It was sad to discover that a school of over **1000** students only had **one** first aid kit with **10** bandaids in it. All of this to say, that there is a GREAT NEED. I had the opportunity to make up 19 kits and take them to the school. They could use around 10 more kits if the funds are available.
