Many of you know that in April, I started experiencing some heart arrhythmia problems. After several visits to the hospital and few answers, I consulted my cardiologist in the US and it was decided I needed to return to the States to seek further treatment. I arrived back in Pennsylvania in the beginning of May and saw the Cardiac Specialist on May 16th. He acknowledged that the problem I am having is not life threatening, but can be life altering. We decided on a plan for me to wear a heart monitor for 2 weeks and then make a treatment plan based off of those results. I just completed this monitoring and am now awaiting those results. Thankfully, I am feeling some better due to medication adjustments and this may be all that is needed.

I was also able to be here for my uncle's funeral and see my mom's family during this difficult time.
