I have to admit last year was a rough year with many health issues, an unexpected trip to the States, and a very BIG decision about moving to work in Port Elizabeth. The Lord has really allowed me time to draw closer to him, as well as get to know the healthcare system from the inside (not really how I expected to do my research). I ended the year on a happy note, celebrating

the end of 2019 and bringing in the New Year with my Knysna Team Members. I am happy to report that the family that I have been working with in Knysna are in good hands with Pastor and Mrs. Schmidt. Chris, has now made a profession of faith, and while he has a lot of growing to do it is amazing to see some of the changes that he has already made in his life. Pray that Chris and Monique continue to grow in Christ.

In December, I made application to change the status of my visa to move to Port Elizabeth, pray that my change is accepted. If they approve it, this will also extend my visa another 3 years.

On January 2nd, with the help of my Knysna Team, I packed and moved to transition to a new ministry working with Brent and Selina

Bergey and Little Fish Ministries. To say that the move was eventful, would be an understatement, but I am thankful for the safety and that all of my belongings made it. PRAISE THE LORD. After being in Port Elizabeth for only a few days, I again began to experience more severe breathing issues. Last week one of my attacks, took me to the emergency room and while sometimes we want to question why, other times, God clearly shows us. In the 10 hours I was in the ER, 2 women came in seeking treatment after trying to abort their babies. Due to the circumstances the abortions had to be completed. It was hard to listen to the doctor tell them, "If you had just come in and asked, we would have done an abortion for free." It made me think that if in 10 hours in one hospital 2 babies were killed, then how many more had occurred across South Africa and across the world. The need to educate young women here is a great need. To show them the love of Christ and how every life is worth saving, even the unborn. I'm so excited to see how the Lord will use me among the people of Port Elizabeth (PE).

When God called me to join the Bergey's in PE, I had no idea that this would include working with a very new church plant, Abundant Life Baptist Church in Walmer. However, it is exciting to be a part of this ministry. Sunday we had a visitor who came and also accepted Christ as her personal Savior. Please pray that we continue to reach others for Christ in the New Year. Thank you for your continued prayers over the last several years and I look forward to being able to share with you what God is going to do in and through me here in Port Elizabeth in 2020!
