Many churches and individuals have given towards the purchase of first aid kits. Because of your donations, I have funding for 65 first aid kits. So far, I have been able to provide Fraasig Primary School with 27 kits, as well as 1 kit to the Sivuyele School for the deaf (see pic to right). I know of many more who are in need and am thankful that the Lord has provided the funding to fulfill this need.



In the month of November, several of the surrounding areas experienced wildfires. During this time, I spent some time in the hospital because of my asthma. I just want to say thank you for your prayers during this time. I am glad to say that life is back to “normal”. The air is clear and so are my lungs and I am very thankful for the Lord's healing.

Over the last several months, I have been able to meet with Queen for a weekly Bible Study. I have also had the opportunity to get to know Monique and her newborn, Lily. She is a new mom who delivered her baby in the provincial hospital. When she returned home, she had NO idea what was normal or abnormal when it came to her and her baby. I have had the opportunity to educate her and assist her in the process of being a new mom. I am also trying to use this time to share Christ with her. Please pray for the salvation of her and her husband, Chris. I have also had the privilege to continue working in the Sunday School ministry at Lagoonside Baptist Church, as well as working with the Embark youth ministry.

I am so thankful that I have been able to move into more permanent housing and how the Lord provided for this need in such an amazing way.

As in most places in the world, December is a busy month preparing for the holidays. I have joined a community acapella choir and we will be performing at a Carol sing on December 21st. It has been a great way to meet new people.

In the New Year, I ask that you pray with me as I seek further opportunities to reach the women of Knysna. I am praying about starting a single ladies ministry as well as starting some classes for expectant mothers and new parents.
