Greetings in the glorious name of our risen Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ, we pray that this finds you all faithful and serving in the work of the gospel.

This last month, we were blessed to be able to present our ministry in four churches in the states of Mississippi, Pennsylvania, and Virginia. While we have enjoyed traveling the country to be with various churches, we are also very excited that we are just about finished with this chapter of our lives and are now headed towards to the mission field.

We are happy to report that we have booked our tickets to fly to Papua New Guinea!! We are currently scheduled to depart on March 30th!! We had originally intended to try to fly out sometime around the beginning of February, but due to the current travel restrictions, the soonest flight available that can accommodate our family and situation is on March 30th. It has been 2 full years since I left off pastoring in Brunswick, Georgia to begin our preparations to head out for the deputation trail, and after all this time, we couldn't be more excited to finally have tickets booked!!

We have also been informed that our visas are being sent to the PNG embassy in Washington D.C. so that they can be pasted into our passports so we can be to be approved to arrive in PNG!! We greatly appreciate every one of you that has continued to pray for this paperwork to come back approved, and we trust that you will continue to pray for us as we work to finalize the remaining needed arrangements before our departure. We are required to submit proof of our tickets, and other documentation showing that we have arranged for a place to quarantine for 2 weeks when we arrive in PNG. This will have to be approved by the government office in PNG before we can depart, and although we don't foresee any issues, we still ask that you remember this in your prayers.

Lastly, we covet your prayers as we wrap up our final preparations before we depart. We are already aware that the next two months will be a blur as we pack our things, say goodbye to family and friends, and spend some time with our home church. Our whole family is very excited to be this close to flying out to Papua New Guinea, and we know that God has exciting things planned for us in the very near future, but we cannot express how much we value your support and prayers as we move to Papua New Guinea!
