Greetings in the lovely name of our wonderful Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. I hope and pray you all are faithfully serving in the place God has placed you.

As we finish out 2019, and head into this new year, we can't help but reflect on how good God has been to us this last year as we traveled the USA on deputation. We have been blessed to present our ministry in 99 churches across 17 different states and have seen the Lord provide for our every need over and over again in ways that simply amaze us. Our time on deputation so far has been full of wonderful experiences, but of course, we are looking forward to the day when we can depart for Papua New Guinea and begin the work there that God has called us to do.

It is our desire/goal to be able to depart for Papua New Guinea by September of 2020, but only the Lord knows what lies ahead for us this year. I am working to continue booking meetings for this year, and the Lord has provided us with quite a few meetings already. We trust and pray that God will allow us to book meetings with churches this year that have a similar vision for Papua New Guinea and the great need in that country.

This month, we spent much of our time traveling back to the east coast from our time in Arizona. We were blessed to be able to present our ministry in various churches in New Mexico, Oklahoma, Mississippi,Kentucky, and South Carolina on the way. The trip was long, but we praise God for the fruitful meetings, and the safety on the road. Driving back and forth across this country pulling a camper can definitely have its scary moments, but God has been faithful to protect us from any damage or harm on the road.

We are also thankful that we were able to spend five days at the end of December in Beaufort, South Carolina at my parent's house packing up some of our stuff that we are planning to ship over to Papua New Guinea this spring via a ministry in North Carolina. We were able to pack up various books, clothes, and other necessary items into ten large totes. It was a hectic few days of sorting and packing, but we are very excited that we have the majority of this project behind us!

In a previous letter, I had mentioned that we were praying that God would allow our support to reach 50% by the end of the year, and we had asked you all to pray with us also for this milestone to be met. Well, we are excited to report that this month we learned of 5 new supporters, and an already supporting church that doubled our support. With this increase, we are happy to report that we currently have 53% of our support committed. Praise the Lord for His constant provision!! Please continue to pray that our support will continue to increase in order that we might be able to depart for the mission field as soon as possible. We are also happy to report that we have been able to save another 4% of our setup fund this month. This brings us to 19% of the \$40,000.00 we are trying to set aside to help us get to and then setup on the mission field. We are very thankful for the generosity of the various individuals and churches that have made these funds available for us!!

Please remember us in prayer this month as we will be presenting our ministry to churches in Tennessee, Louisiana, Texas, and Mississippi. We will be driving a lot of miles and meeting with multiple churches, and you don't know how much your prayers are coveted and appreciated!
