## Brethren,

September 3, 2020

Greetings in the lovely name of our risen Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. I hope and prav this finds you all well and faithful in the service our great God.

In August, we were blessed to present our ministry to 7 different churches in 5 different states. We have also received news that 4 more churches have made the decision to financially support us!! This allows us to report that we have 82% of our needed support committed!! Please pray with us that we will continue to see our support be raised over the coming months.

In September, we do not have very many meetings scheduled to present our ministry. In the last few weeks we have had quite a few churches cancel due to the current Covid situation. Since the baby is due to arrive in the next few weeks, we have not tried to book too many replacement meetings for this month in order to allow us to stay close to home for the remainder of the pregnancy. We do have a pretty full schedule booked for the rest of this year beginning in October, and we are praving that nothing will hinder these meetings.

This last month, we learned that the Papua New Guinea government will again be processing new applications for work permits. We have been working these last couple weeks to fill out, gather, and send in all the necessary paperwork to apply for a work permit. We just received news that the sponsoring national pastor in Papua New Guinea has signed off on our application and our paperwork has been forwarded on to the government office for approval. As soon as we receive approval, we can submit our request for visas to enter Papua New Guinea. Please pray that we will receive approval quickly on this work permit application in order to allow us to depart for Papua New Guinea around January/February of this coming year.

Also, at the end of September, we will be taking quite a few totes to a shipping ministry in North Carolina. We are sending over quite a few totes filled with lots of gospel tracts, clothing, school and study books, and other household items we will need to set up our house and ministry in PNG. The shipping ministry has informed us that the container will leave around the end of October and should arrive in the highlands of PNG around the beginning of next year.

Lastly, please keep Sheila and the new baby in your prayers as the baby is due to arrive this month and we are just praying for a healthy delivery. The doctors have given us good reports up to this point and we are trusting the Lord to keep both Sheila and the baby safe for the remainder of this pregnancy.
