Greetings in the lovely name of our wonderful Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. We hope and pray you all are doing well, and remaining faithful in the service of our glorious Lord and King.

We know that all of you are currently being affected by the corona pandemic the world is facing at this time and please know that our family is praying those of you that we have had the joy of meeting and getting to know so far on deputation. We are praying that this will pass quickly and allow us all to get back to some sense of "normal."

Like so many others, we have had some things change in our schedule due to the virus. We had a few meetings cancel or reschedule in the last few weeks as many churches are adjusting their services. My wife and I were also scheduled to go to Papua New Guinea in April for about three weeks, but of course that has been cancelled now as well. The airlines have refunded us all the funds that we had previously paid for the tickets so we are excited to be able to use these monies to have a head start on the tickets we will need for our permanent move to Papua New Guinea. But none of these things move us, as we are still excited to be moving forward towards the date when we can leave for the mission field. We trust that the Lord will continue to provide our every need as well as the needs of all the missionaries and churches being affected by these strange times.

In spite of all the uncertainty in recent days, we are actually happy to report that we have received news of 3 new supporters in the month of March. This new support means we have 63% of our needed support committed!! We praise the Lord for His continued provision!! **Please continue to pray that we will see our support level increase in the coming days in order to allow us to depart for the mission field by December of this year.** 

This last month, we were contacted by a church that had allowed us to present our ministry over a year ago. They informed us that they were unable to find a new pastor and eventually had to close their doors. They told us, that upon closing, they had decided to send us the remainder of their funds to help us with our Setup fund. While we were saddened to hear of the closing of a church, we also rejoice to see the Lord continue to provide the funds necessary to establish our family in Papua New Guinea. **We are excited to report that we now have 50% of our setup fund set aside!!** 

Since we were originally scheduled to be in Papua New Guinea this month, we did not schedule many meetings in April, but since we are now going to be in the states, we plan to use this time to catch up on some needed study, schoolwork and other necessary business. We have been blessed to line up a few wonderful places to stay this month, and are looking forward to seeing how the Lord will bless in the days to come.
