Future Ministry

In a few short days we will be returning to the capital of Phnom Penh after finishing our time covering for a fellow missionary while they were on furlough. We are excited to tell you that God is leading us to begin our own ministry in the city of Chbar Mon. This city has a population of roughly 60,000 with no independent fundamental Baptist Church. The whole province has approx. 800,000 people with very few churches. We are praying that we can find a house to rent, furnish the house, and move there by the end of April. Please be in prayer for us. A house in Cambodia can either be a great blessing in ministry or a great distraction to the ministry. Pray for a house with a good water supply, enough electricity, and in the right neighborhood.

Upcoming Furlough

Our goal is to be able to live in Chabar Mon for 3 months before taking a 6-month furlough. This will allow us to better understand the opportunities and challenges that await us, while also giving opportunity to begin building relationships with our neighbors and local authorities. Furthermore, upon our return from furlough, we will have a full 4-year term to work on starting a church.
