We are still unable to return to Okinawa. We were contacted by Delta and they informed us that our tickets would have to be pushed back because they could not get a confirmation from Japan that the flights would be allowed in. This is the fifth time that our tickets have been pushed back and we will now be returning to Okinawa in March 2021. Please pray for our church as this latest re-booking will leave us with an empty church. All the current members of North Shore will have moved on to new assignments by the time we return. Without the ability to visit/invite people to church we will be starting from scratch again. This is not a daunting task because we know that ultimately the church is the Lord's and He will grow it.



Isn't God awesome! Nothing that has transpired has caught Him by surprise. Since we are not able to go back to Okinawa, we are able to assist another military missionary in Germany. We will be flying to Germany on September 1st to fill in as interim pastor for Heritage Baptist Church in Mehlingen. It is amazing to see how God moves and allows His people to minister. Heritage is a church we used to minister in and now God is bringing us full circle as we go to minister there again. Please pray for the dear people of Heritage as they await the arrival of their new pastor. Please pray that we can be a blessing and encouragement to them and that God will see mighty things from this little church in the near future. Also, please pray that we have safe travels and that we will not encounter any issues getting into Germany.
