Dear Pastors and Co-laborers,

With that said, we are faced with a situation that each and every military ministry is all too familiar with, TDY/Deployed members. We currently have 10 members that are away due to the mission they are supporting. Please pray for not only their safety but also their testimony to be a light in this dark world.

Since we started NSBC in November 2017 we have found several things to be clearly evident, some of those are: Our U.S. service members are subject to a constant barrage from Satan and his demons. There is little offered by the military to counter this barrage. And finally, the family seems to be the number one target of these attacks. All around the world you will find the forces of Satan attempting to destroy the God ordained institute of the family.
