This is not a collection location for furniture, electronics, books, household items, toys, pillows, rags or fabric scraps. It is extremely helpful if items are in plastic bags and are not left outside the shed. The items are picked up by St. Pauly Textile, and St. Peter's receives a check monthly for those items, based on the number of pounds of items collected. We are very fortunate that Steve and Lori Stumpf monitor the clothing shed and take care of any issues that might come up.
