•	The Hebrew title for Numbers is "Bemidbar" which means "In the W" Numbers explains how a journey that should have taken them just about 2 weeks turned into 40 years of wandering in the wilderness.

-	Those 12 spies had all seen the same things: they had seen God do the impossible and they had scoped out the same land. But only 2 of them actually believed that God would be faithful. Joshua and Caleb had a "different spirit," they wholeheartedly followed God. Christ gives us a new heart. If you want to be courageous, don't think about being courageous: set your heart
