The Bible in One Year Week 11: Numbers (Pt. 1)

Exodus 34:6-7; Numbers 13-14; Joshua 1:9; Psalm 16:8; 2 Timothy 1:7

Courage

- **It takes C_____ to walk with God**

The Story we've been reading from Genesis, to Exodus, to Leviticus, and now Numbers, has been about *renewing* that blessing, *recovering* that image, and *restoring* that intimacy from the Garden. And this journey from Fall to Redemption, from Captivity to Freedom, from Wilderness to Promised Land is going to take *courage*.

- **Courage comes from the strength of heart to assert my will in spite of my F_____ and C_____.**

Courage is most truly activated when my heart and will are aligned with God's.

In the Wilderness

- **The Hebrew title for Numbers is “Bemidbar” which means “In the W_____”**

Numbers explains how a journey that should have taken them just about 2 weeks turned into 40 years of wandering in the wilderness.

- **Numbers is about the tension between God's F_____ and our Un_____**

We're all faced with the potential for victory or wandering, but God doesn't waste the wilderness.

- **The 12 became the 10 and 2**

Those 12 spies had all seen the same things: they had seen God do the impossible and they had scoped out the same land. But only 2 of them actually believed that God would be faithful. Joshua and Caleb had a “different spirit,” they wholeheartedly followed God. Christ gives *us* a new heart. If you want to be courageous, don't think about being courageous: set your heart wholly upon the Lord.
