Flowers can be picked up **after late service** on Easter Sunday or the following Sunday after either service. They will be given away or disposed of after Sunday, April 11. Unlike past years, specific colors of flowers cannot be chosen – there will be a mix of colors provided. If you have questions, please call Brenda or Tim Walck at 695-4374. Profits from this sale will go toward the new church audio/visual system.

AS YOU KNOW, we've been praying for Lori Haseley from St. James. She has been waiting for a liver donor. On March 15, she will be receiving that liver, a new gift of life. Please pray for her, the donor, her doctors and nurses, and of course, her family. It will be a long day for all and a long recovery for Lori.

COMMUNION CHANGES: Commencing on Maundy Thursday, April 1, a hybrid communion service will be initiated. For those who wish to continue using the packets and remaining in the pews, they will take communion first at that point in the service. For those who wish to participate in continuous distribution, the following procedure will be followed. Pastor, gloved and masked, will serve the bread. Communicants should come forward, socially distanced with their mask on, and receive the bread from Pastor. After the bread is given, communicants should move to the side toward the Elder, lower their mask, eat the bread, raise their mask, and walk toward the Elder. When reaching the Elder, who will be gloved and masked, either wine or white grape juice will be given after which communicants should move away from the Elder, lower their mask, drink the wine/grape juice, raise the mask, and return to the pew. This process will be reviewed at the beginning of the service. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact Pastor or the Elders.

THE MILITARY STICK FUNDRAISER will start this week and run through the end of the month. If you wish to donate, please place your donation in the offering plate clearly marked "Military Sticks." All funds raised will receive a 100% match by a private donor connected with the Military Stick organization.

AFTER TODAY, we will no longer be taking temperatures upon entry into the church. This is in accordance with CDC guidelines for religious organizations.

THE CHURCH COUNCIL has adopted a new Records Retention and Disposition Schedule which will be distributed to all officers of the congregation.

IF YOU HAVE NOT ALREADY DONE SO, PLEASE COMPLETE a communion card and either give it to an Elder or place it in the offering plate in the church entrance. This only needs to be done once annually. Thank you.
