Morning Worship Sermon Outline

Text: Mark 5:21-43 Title: Jesus is LORD of ALL

Introduction: In these four panoramas beginning at Mark 4:34 through the end of Mark 5, the inspired writer is showing us that Jesus is:

I. LORD over all creation (Mark 4: 34-41) Jesus calms the sea with a word.

II. LORD over all the spiritual realms (Mark 5:1-20)Jesus casts out a legion of demons (evil spirits) from a man held in total bondage to the evil one.

III. LORD over sickness and disease (Mark 5: 25-34) Jesus heals a woman while on his way to the house of Jairus. She has had this issue of blood for 12 years and was worse each day.

IV. LORD over death (Mark 5:21-24 and 35-43)

Jesus was approached by Jairus, the synagogue ruler, to come and lay hands on his 12 year old dying daughter. Jesus is going but is interrupted by the woman with the issue of blood. Afterwards men come to tell Jairus that his little girl is dead. Jesus tells him to not be afraid but to only believe. Jesus has caused the faith of Jairus to increase as he saw the woman miraculously healed. Jesus raises his daughter from the dead.

Conclusion: With all this evidence that Jesus is Savior and Lord, He is assuring us that all who come to Him in humility and faith will find Him to be the true and perfect Savior that we need.
