

<sup>9</sup> Moses commanded **Joshua**, "Choose some men to go out and **fight** the **army** of **Amalek** for us. Tomorrow, I will stand at the top of the hill, **holding** the **staff** of **God** in my **hand**."

<sup>10</sup> So Joshua did what Moses had commanded and fought the army of Amalek. Meanwhile, **Moses**, **Aaron**, and **Hur** climbed to the top of a nearby **hill**. <sup>11</sup> As long as Moses held up the staff in his hand, the **Israelites** had the **advantage**. But whenever he dropped his hand, the Amalekites gained the advantage. <sup>12</sup> Moses' **arms** soon became so tired he could no longer hold them up. So Aaron and Hur found a stone for him to sit on. Then they stood on each side of Moses, holding up his hands. So his hands held steady until sunset. <sup>13</sup> As a result, Joshua beat the army of Amalek in battle.




