Greetings in the lovely name of our risen Lord and Saviour, Jesus Christ. We hope and pray this finds you well and faithful in the service of our Lord!!

This is indeed an exciting letter for us to write!! This is because our next letter will be sent out after we arrive in Papua New Guinea, Lord willing!!

Last month, we asked you to pray with us that our quarantine application would be approved in time for us to be able to board our flights at this end of March. We can happily report that our application was approved!! We were expecting this to take a while to get returned, as many folks have told us that these applications have taken weeks and even months to be approved, but we actually received it back in less than 24 hours!!

Not only are we approved, but we were also cleared to be able to spend our 14 days of quarantine in Mount Hagen (the city we will be living in when we get to PNG). This means we will only be just down the street from the Eric Fair family, another missionary family from our home church who have made themselves available to help us with any needs we may have during these 2 weeks. This will be a tremendous help to us both practically and financially!!

In February, we were blessed to visit 5 different churches in the states of New York, Ohio, and Tennessee, and are happy to report that we have also received news of 2 new supporting churches!! We do not have many meetings scheduled for this month, and our travel will be very limited as we plan to spend most of our remaining time here in Beaufort, South Carolina with our home church and family as we pack and prepare for our departure from on March 29<sup>th</sup> from Savannah GA

When we leave Savannah, we will head to Los Angeles, where we will board the international leg of our journey. We will fly to Hong Kong, and then, after a 14-hour layover, we will head to the capital city of Papua New Guinea, Port Moresby. Once we arrive in Port Moresby on Aril 1st, Mission Aviation Fellowship is scheduled to fly us up to our destination in Mount Hagen. We ask that you remember us in your prayers as we head out on this incredible journey around the globe to start our new life in Papua New Guinea.

While we are counting down the days until we leave, we also know that a lot still must be done to pack and prepare. We are completely convinced that we would not have made it to this point without your prayers, therefore we greatly covet your prayers in the days to come, as we transition to our new life in Papua New Guinea.
