"Easter Sunday!"

Next Sunday is incredibly special! First and foremost, it is a day of celebrating the Resurrection of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! I can hear, "enough said!" Indeed! But there is more! The Graham Street Church Family is so excited about this very special day for many reasons.

The Community Easter Sunrise Service is at the amphitheater in the City Park at 6:45. Several community churches are coming together to worship. I am excited to share a message from 1 Corinthians 15! Bring your lawn chairs to stay and visit and share breakfast together in the park.

Then at 9:00 our church family will gather at Graham Street for Bible Classes for all ages, and at 10:00 for worship in ONE service. It is going to great to be together in fellowship to sing, share the Word, pray, take communion, and give! There will still be some things that are different. We will provide a special seating area on the left side of the auditorium as you enter for those who wish to mask and social distance. Please respect those who are at risk and need to sit in this area. Also allow those who need close access to the entrance to use the westside parking lot. We will continue to use the communion packets and we will encourage sanitizing your hands upon entering the building and wearing masks in the lobby. The balcony will be open for overflow seating.

Parking may be a challenge. The rain has delayed the start of the construction on Graham Street in front of the building, but it will be starting soon, and if it starts before Easter, both intersections at Green St and Tarleton St will be closed. You will be able to go through the barriers to park in the west lot and Green Street lots. The hospital has given us permission to park in their lot across Belknap from the Visitor entrance. The Family Center parking lot is accessible by entering the Green St entrance from Virginia Street behind the Family Center. However, the Family Center will be cut off from a direct crossing to the main building by foot and car traffic. You will also face the same challenges in parking in the bank parking lot. Be careful and please do not let your children play close to the construction site that will have a dangerous drop off from the sidewalk.

And speaking of children, don't forget the Easter Egg Hunt at the Museum Sunday afternoon!

Easter is traditionally a day of spiritual renewal, and after a year of COVID, we are looking forward to the revival it will bring to the Graham Street Church of Christ!
