Is not this the word that we did tell thee in Egypt, saying, Let us alone, that we may serve the Egyptians? For it had been better for us to serve the Egyptians, than that we should die in the wilderness. And Moses said unto the people, Fear ye not, stand still, and see the salvation of the LORD, which he will shew to you to day: for the Egyptians whom ye have seen to day, ye shall see them again no more for ever. For years as they labored as slaves in Egypt, the children of Israel cried out to God for deliverance. They despaired when Pharaoh gave the command for all male Hebrew babies to be killed. They had no freedom or ability to control their own lives. When Moses came, many of them rejoiced that the ancient promises of God to His people were being remembered and fulfilled. After ten plagues devastated the land of Egypt, and Pharaoh finally agreed to let them go, they went out loaded down with treasure, heading for the land promised to their people
