Principle 1: Working together for a common goal.

Introduction: Review last week

"Teamwork" was Key to Rebuilding the Wall of Jerusalem in Nehemiah

Principle 1: They made a commitment and began the work. In order to work together for a common goal, you must know the goal. (video Illustration of Nick Saban)

- 1. What is our goal as individual Christians and collectively as a church?
 - a. We call it the Great Commission (Mat. 28:18-20)
 - b. Our goal is to be and make disciples of Christ. But what is a "disciple"?
 - c. To follow and learn from the teacher to become like him.
- 2. God's Eternal Plan for Discipleship
 - a. Christ came into this world to show us God in the flesh (John 1:14-18)
 - b. We are to become like Christ (Rom. 8:29; 2 Cor. 3:18; John 13 &15)
 - c. We become like Christ and show the glory of Christ, like His glory was to show the glory of God (Eph. 4:11-16; Eph. 2:19-22; 3:10-11, 20-21; 1 Cor. 3:10-11, 16-17; 6:19; 1 Pet. 2:3-12; Mat. 5:14-16)
- 3. "Rooted, Growing, Reaching"
