WE ARE IN PAPUA NEW GUINEA!!!! PRAISE THE LORD!!!!

We are so excited to report that we are finally on Papua New Guinea soil! We arrived here on April 1st, after 3 days of flying and layovers. We flew out of Savannah, Georgia around 1:20pm on Monday, March 29th and we finally arrived in Mount Hagen, Papua New Guinea around 11am on April 1st (which is about 9pm the day before in the USA). We were so exhausted when we arrived but also extremely excited and relieved to finally be in Papua New Guinea!!

The month of March was incredibly hectic and emotional to say the least as we made our last-minute preparations to depart. We moved out of our camper and packed everything that we could take into 13 bags weighing 50lbs apiece and our carryon bags. All but one of our bags arrived in Papua New Guinea without any issue. The last bag is lost somewhere between Los Angeles and Port Moresby, Papua New Guinea. **Please pray that they will find this missing luggage and be able to get it to us sometime in the next few weeks. We know it is a long shot, but we know that God is aware of where this bag is and how to get it to us.**

As you can imagine, our final days in the USA were just a whirlwind of emotions as we said goodbye to family, friends, and our home/sending church, Calvary Baptist Church in Beaufort SC. I was blessed to be asked to preach the AM service, and the church had a special send-off service for our family during that PM service. Our previous pastor, Karl Baker, and Pastor Jonathon Doss from King James Bible Baptist church in Monks Corner, SC (men who have been great mentors to me in my past), came into town to preach this service. The Lord directed both these men to preach from Colossians 4:17, and it was a great service to say the least. Many tearful goodbyes, encouraging words, and promises to pray were exchanged.

The current government order requires all new arrivals in Papua New Guinea to perform a 14-day quarantine upon arrival into the country, so we are “under house arrest” until April 15th. We were able to get it approved to do our quarantine in Mount Hagen, the city we will be living in, instead of the capital city of Port Moresby. Eric and Andraea Fair, fellow-missionaries from our home church, also live in this same city, and they have been a huge blessing in providing us with groceries, fresh fruits/vegetables from the market, and other necessities that we are unable to get for ourselves due to our inability to leave these premises.

Please pray for us as we have plenty to do to get “settled” into the country here as soon as we leave quarantine on April 15th. We are so very excited about what lies ahead, and we know that just as it took the prayers of you to get us here, it is going to take your prayers to keep us here and help us adjust to this new life we have been led to live in this place known as the Land of the Unexpected!”
