We are truly amazed at the work God has done here! Over 25,000 Gospel Tracts have been distributed and over 150 souls have been saved! Our young church has seen over 40 saved and

15 baptized with many 100s of visitors! We have more people involved in 1-on-1 discipleship than ever before! We also recently restarted our **Bible Institute!** We praise God

for 9 students God has given us up from 4 that completed our first course!

Just these past 2 months, we have seen 8 more trust Christ as their Savior and 4 more baptized! These past 3 years have not been without their challenges. War, protests, riots, opposition, pain, transitions, loneliness, and sickness have all been part of the journey since we arrived here.

I recently went through the most physically painful experience of my life. I woke up with a lump that turned out to be an abscess. I had to have an operation to drain the infection and a painful recovery. God taught me many things through this time. I praise Him for the pain that drew me closer to Him and for the healing!



We have been working so hard for so long on processing our legal papers to be able to stay long-term in Ethiopia. I'm so thrilled to

share with you that I received mv WORK PERMIT as the Pastor of our church, International Bible Baptist Church in Legetafo. I will be picking up our residency IDs for our entire family in just a few short days! This is such a HUGE PRAISE I'm not sure if I should shout or crv!
