## Curriculum Overview

The Get Set For School Pre-K curriculum by Learning Without Tears is used by each of our classes. Each week students learn a new letter and number. Each month students focus on specific letter sounds, colors, and shapes. We have a special Bible theme and memory verse each month and a new Bible story every week during Chapel.

Music, science, and art classes take place weekly and help reinforce lessons learned in class and chapel in a fun way.

Special days include a zoo field trip, donuts with dad & muffins with mom, visits from police officers and firefighters, Thankful harvest, holiday parties, and so much more!

### Two Year Olds

8:2 ratio

Social and fine motor skills; Letter and letter sound recognition; Color and shape recognition; Number to 10 and counting with one to one correspondence; Potty training

### Three Year Olds

6:1 ratio

Social and fine motor skills; Letter and letter sound recognition; Beginning writing; Color and shape recognition; Sorting and patterns; Number recognition and counting with one to one correspondence to 20

### Four Year Olds

8:1 ratio

Social and fine motor skills; Letter name and sound recognition; Beginning sight words and word families; Writing; Color and shape recognition; Sorting and patterns; Number recognition and counting with one to one correspondence to 20
