

## HOW TO JOIN A ZOOM MEETING

Copy the meeting ID from the email or flier inviting you to the meeting. If there is a meeting passcode, keep it handy.


### A. You can join a zoom meeting right from From your phone

1. Dial +1 346 248 7799 US (or any other number provided for zoom to *Dial by your location*).
2. When prompted, enter the Meeting ID
3. When prompted, enter the Passcode

### B. You can join a zoom meeting right from the internet without creating an account.


1. Click the link provided in the email. **OR**

2. Go to zoom.us




3. At the top of the screen, find the blue text link that says: **JOIN A MEETING** and click it.

4. Paste the Meeting ID you copied into the box in the middle of the screen and click the **Join** button.




5. You might see a pop-up window like this:



Click the Open **Zoom.US** button.

6. You will see a box that looks like this:



Type in your Meeting Passcode and click the **Join** button. And wait. It might take 30-60 seconds for your host to let you in the meeting and for everything, including your sound and microphone, to connect.

*Sometimes, when you click the **Open zoom.us** button in step 5, it can look like nothing happened. This is often because your passcode box from step 6 is hiding somewhere. You might have to look around for it on your screen by moving or minimizing your other windows.*
