Aloha MBC 'ohana,

Hau'oli makahiki hou! I don't know if you can believe it or not, but we've made it to 2021. After a pretty tumultuous year, here we are, at the start of a new year. For many, a new year symbolizes new beginnings, the onset of new dreams, new plans, and new goals. For MBC, we will be starting the new year by looking back to our roots. Over the next 5 Sundays, we'll be taking a topical look as Pastor Kaleb, and I work through our church mission statement together. In July of 1975, our church began with the purpose of reaching Mililani with the gospel of Jesus Christ. Our vision and mission have not changed, although there have been variations in the wording over time. Jesus, in Acts 1:8, gave the disciples a precise order, saying, "you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." We believe that our primary role in Mililani Town, on O'ahu, in Hawai'i, and ultimately on Earth is still valid, and thus, there is still work to do.

We, at MBC, exist to "glorify God with a passion for Him and a compassion for others." Regarding having a passion for God, one of my favorite theologians, R.C. Sproul, once said this, "We do not segment our lives, giving some time to God, some to our business or schooling, while keeping parts to ourselves. The idea is to live all of our lives in the presence of God, under the authority of God, and for the honor and glory of God. That is what the Christian life is all about." So how do we do that, live a life in the presence of God? I believe that we do it, just as our mission statement says: "[Our mission is] to be a loving family of believers who together worship, share, connect, grow, and serve." That statement, posted in nearly every room of the church, is how we plan to reach Mililani with the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The only way to see this vision and mission come to fruition is to become passionate about fulfilling the Great Commission by making disciples who make disciples.

As we focus on discipleship, we will start the year by introducing three new Sunday School classes, each focused on teaching and developing disciples through various topical and theological studies. Our early service will return at 8 am on Sunday mornings and our Men's and Women's Studies during the week. With each ministry that comes back, we will continue to adhere to the restrictions and guidelines that have been placed before us. There are many other things that we are excited about doing, and as a staff, we are excited about what God will do through MBC in 2021.

Of course, as I mention all of this, I would be remiss if I did not sincerely thank you for your aloha spirit and support in calling me to be your pastor. I am truly humbled and grateful for you and your partnership in the ministry of MBC. Together, we will see God do some incredible things, not because of us or me, in particular, but because of the amazing God we serve. It is a joy and an honor to serve you, and I can't wait to see the Spirit's continued work in this place.
