April 25, 2021 Memorial Baptist “What the Cross Means to the World”

Text: 1 Corinthians 1:18-23

1) The Cross is Confusing: Verse 23 “But we preach Christ crucified: a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to the Gentiles”

Acts 17:20 “you are bringing some strange idea to our ears, and we want to know what they mean.”

2) The Cross Judges the World: Verse 18a “For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing.”

Isaiah 64:6 All of us have become like one who is unclean, and all our righteous acts are like filthy rags; we all shrivel up like a leaf, and like the wind our sins sweep us away.

Isaiah 61:10 I delight greatly in the LORD; my soul rejoices in my God. For he has clothed me with garments of salvation and arrayed me in a robe of righteousness.

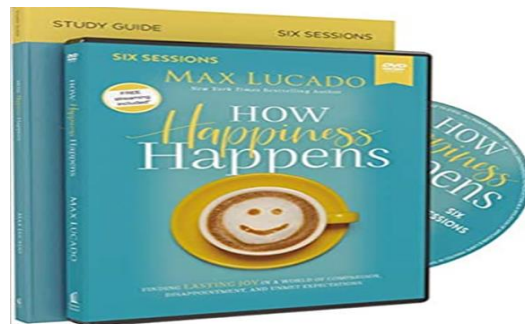
Isaiah 1:18 “Come now, let us reason together,” says the LORD. “Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool.”

3) The Cross Saves the World: Verse 18b “To us who are being saved it is the power of God.”

John 3:15-16 Everyone who believes in him may have eternal life. “For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

I John 5:13 I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.

Romans 10:9-10 That if you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.
