LESSONS FROM FIRST SAMUEL

1 Samuel 2:26 "And the boy **Samuel continued to grow** in stature and **in favor** with the Lord and with people."

Does that sound familiar?

Luke wrote, "And **Jesus grew** in wisdom and stature, and **in favor** with God and man." Luke 2:52

LESSONS TO LEARN:

- Grow In God's Favor and Make Sacrifices.
 - Even though Eli wasn't the perfect father figure, Samuel still grew up following God and it resulted in him being in God's favor.
 - Likewise, Jesus' earthly father wasn't perfect and yet He grew up in wisdom and in favor with God and man.
 - We also are told to **grow in the grace** of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. (2 Peter 3:18)
 - Samuel was a priest (1 Samuel 7:9), Jesus is our High Priest (Hebrews 3:1) and we are part of a holy priesthood (1 Peter 2:5).
 - Let us follow the examples of Samuel and Jesus and offer sacrifices to God. Let us offer our bodies as a living sacrifice (Romans 12:1). Let us financially support our evangelists as a sacrifice to God (Philippians 4:18). Let us continually offer the sacrifice of praise to God, that is, the fruit of our lips, giving thanks to His name (Hebrews 13:15).
