Re: STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS (2021 – 2022 Academic Year)

All applicants must submit a completed application, written essay, and two references. One reference must come from a Christian leader, such as a pastor, youth director, campus ministry leader, or ministry supervisor who knows you well. The second must be a non-family personal reference who knows you well such as a teacher, church member, or coach. Both of these reference forms are included in your scholarship packet.

Please mark clearly on your application which scholarship(s) you are applying for, based on the following guidelines:

Margaretta T. Vanaman Scholarship – *Candidates must be a member of FUMC and active in the youth ministry and/or church for at least one year, OR be active in programs at the Fellowship House for at least one year. They must be someone with good moral character, and be attending or planning to attend an institution of higher learning for at least one year, pursuing a recognized educational degree.*

FUMC Scholarship – *Candidates must be actively involved in the ryver youth ministry for at least one year, and/or be involved in serving within the life of the church. The committee is looking for candidates who are growing in relationship with Jesus, and who display qualities of leadership, service, integrity, concern for others, and spiritual maturity. They must be attending, or planning to attend, an institution of higher learning for at least one year, pursuing a recognized educational degree.*

All applications, with supporting information, are due to the church office **no later than Sunday, May 16th, 2021**. They may be mailed, hand-delivered, or e-mailed to office@fumccollingswood.org.
