Budget: \$9,700 a week YTD Contribution \$ 172,981 (99%) YTD Budget: \$ 174,600

Building Fund \$315,786 (this is the total amount given since start of Phase 2— the funds given to date have been used for the new roof and new A/C units.) We are making plans to start Phase 3 soon!



The section of Graham Street from Green Street through Tarleton Street intersections to a point between Post Office entrance and exit (see map below) is closed due to construction.
