From the Pastor

The damage and power outage caused by the recent ice storm gave most of us a new appreciation for power, lights and heat. It was sheer joy when the electricity was restored to our home after almost five days (I know that pales in comparison with some in our church family who went without power for much longer than that!).

What would have happened if, after my home was restored back to the power grid, all the light switches were turned off and the thermostat was turned to off? I would have continued to sit in darkness and cold, not realizing that all I had to do was turn the light switch on and turn the heat back on to enjoy the "power." How many of our neighbors, though their electricity may have been restored, are still living "powerless"? They are living in spiritual darkness. They are not enjoying the warmth and joy of God's love and grace.

God has commissioned each of us—His followers—to compel others to come into God's light and power. We do that by demonstrating a life of love that is connected to God's "power grid."

The Bible reminds us that we have great power at our disposal:
Now to Him who is able to do above and beyond all that we ask or think according to the power that works in us—to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. Amen (Ephesians 3:20-21 HCSB).

God's unlimited power is flowing in us—if only we would avail ourselves to it. It's the same power that raised Jesus from the dead (see Romans 8:11). Isn't that incredible?

Too many of us are still living "powerless" lives. We are living like we are in the dark and cold, but instead we have the greatest power source ever known ready to jumpstart our lives and help us live lives that bring others to Jesus. That is the kind of power I long for. I pray it is the kind of power you long for as well. Let's ask God to make us conduits of His power—and we can help turn on the "light" in our community!

Children of Promise ministry for their country. Jenny grew up in our church and we are excited to support them through our general budget and Faith Promise.

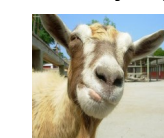
APRIL SPOTLIGHT
