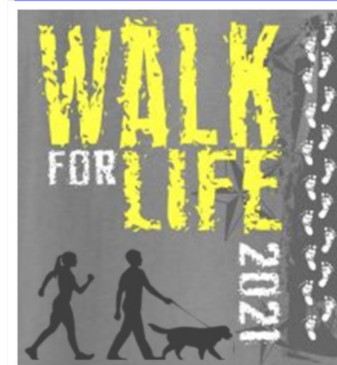

Name Tags

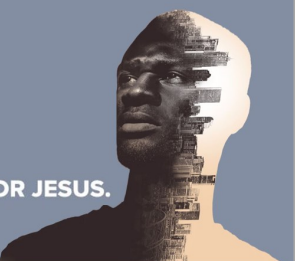
