## Talking about the Second Article of The Apostles' Creed \*

**I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried; He descended into hell; the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father Almighty, from whence He shall come to judge the living and the dead.**

### What does this mean?

I believe that Jesus Christ, true God, begotten of the Father from eternity, and also true man, born of the Virgin Mary, is my Lord, who has redeemed me, a lost and condemned creature, bought and freed me from all sins, from death and from the power of the devil - not with silver and gold, but with His holy and precious blood, and with His innocent sufferings and death - in order that I might be His own, live under Him in His Kingdom, and serve Him in everlasting righteousness, innocence, and blessedness; even as He is risen from the dead, and lives and reigns to all eternity. This is most certainly true.

### **165** What word do we use to describe the coming of God into the world in the person of Jesus?

The word we use to describe this is *incarnation*, which means *in flesh*.

**John 1:14** And the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen his glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.

**Philippians 2:6-7** [Christ Jesus] who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.



### **166** What does the name Jesus mean?

The name *Jesus* means Savior.

**Matthew 1:21** She will bear a son, and you shall call his name Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins."

### **167** What does the word Christ mean when given as a title for Jesus?

The title *Christ* means *Anointed One* or *one set apart by God to be the Savior*.

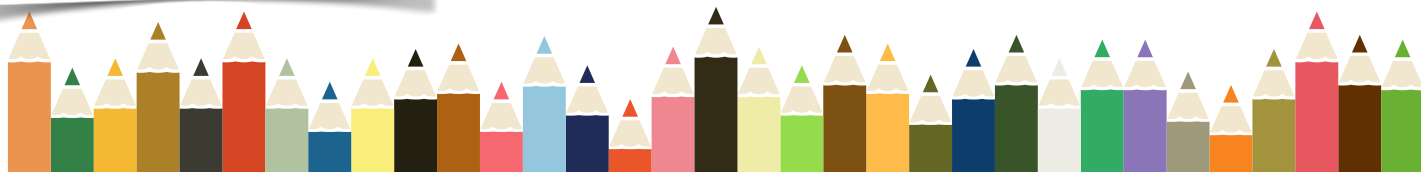
